Improve quality of life in rural areas, higher standard of living and services for citizens.

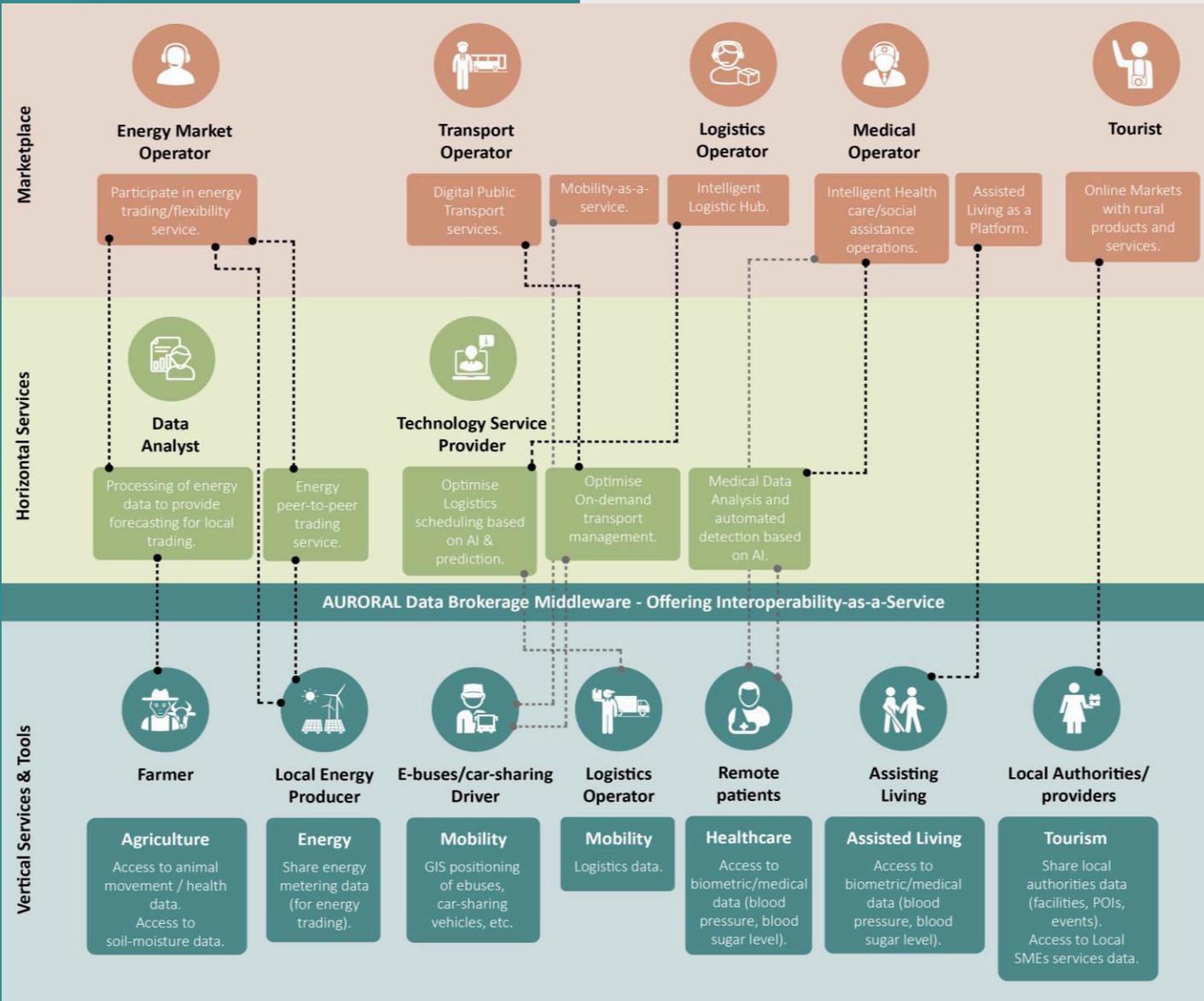
